FROM THE PASTOR

The power of Christ is in the mobilization of God's people to the mission. This core truth defines everything from how we spend money to what ministry programs we do. I'm excited, for that reason, that Cana will host the Harvest America Simulcast on June 10 beginning at 6:00pm. This is an excellent way to provide neighbors and lost people with a hearing of the Gospel. Harvest America is a ministry of Greg Laurie. He will be live at AT&T Stadium in Arlington (You can also take your lost friends or family to the live event but arrive early). Greg presents the gospel in a clear and concise way and then calls people to salvation. Invite your five people for whom you have been praying to attend this event with you.

And it's not just Harvest America where the gospel will go out. We will reach out to families through VBS. Our theme this year is "Go" and it's all about the gospel going out through Paul's ministry. Our kids will learn about their role in missions through the book of Acts. Samantha Nelson, our Interim Children's Minister, is doing a great job of spearheading the VBS event. Crossover, hosted through partnership with SWBTS, will take the Gospel door-to-door in Burleson. Pray for salvation of souls. I am asking the Lord for 15 baptisms in June through these various ministries.

Cana's mission continues to expand near and far. These three events happening near to our location are mirrored by missions far from us. Our youth will lead a mission trip to Dickinson TX. They will lead VBS for Pine Drive Baptist Church. You may remember this church as the one we assisted with chairs after Hurricane Harvey flooded their building. God has done a great work there in spite of their difficult situation. Pray for our youth as they reach out to the neighborhoods surrounding Pine Drive. Our youth play an important role in the revitalization of the church. Our young adults will engage a closed country for a mission work as well. Details of that trip are sensitive due to security concerns, but I can say that God is moving powerfully in that location through people connected to Cana.

Finally, Deaf Camp concludes the busy June missions push. Deaf Camp will be a mission effort to an unreached people group, the deaf. During the last

week of June, families with deaf children will come to a VBS/Camp designed specifically to speak their language. This is a beautiful and unique way of ministering the gospel to lost and little accessed communities. Cana matters to the mission of Christ!

In the meantime, I will teach an all-church class through the Book of Judges on Wednesday nights. The class will begin at 7:00pm each Wednesday of the Summer. The title of the message series is “The Fall of Nations.” We live in turbulent times both at home and throughout the world. This study will show how the message of Judges relates to the decline of nations – how liberty turns to tyranny – and suggest how Christian people support liberty through righteousness. I hope you will invest in this study of the Word!

On Sunday’s I will preach through the Psalms. Make sure to get your devotional guide beginning June 03 so that you can walk through the Psalms during your devotional reading. You can get the guide from any of our greeters or ushers.

A Special Note about SWBTS:

I am saddened by the release of Paige Patterson from SWBTS on May 30, 2018. As a two-time alumni of the seminary, it grieves me for the seminary and for a champion of the SBC. I think the temperature of the world is raging hot against anything that challenges its dominance. We are in the last times the Scripture speaks about when people will not listen to sound reason or Scriptural truth. Please be careful of what you believe. One giant lesson I learned early in leadership is that the details are hardly as clear cut as the opponents suggest. Intention and love don’t always translate into written accounts of past actions especially when one’s opponents are authoring Satan’s words. So pray rather than judge.

This change of leadership does call into question part of our London mission – the seminary portion. We have not received any details yet, it’s too early, but we are asking what the future of a prospective partnership could be. We will make keep you posted on updates as they are known. I remain committed to planting and partnering with our friends in London. I no less believe in the mission there, but we do need to see what will occur in days ahead.
